Title Manager, Stewards, Scrutineers, Transponder Operators, Drivers Representative.

If you would like to be part of the team and have the following please complete the attached form.

- Experience in any of the above positions.
- Good communication skills
- Work as a team
- Understand and implement the code of conduct for officials (see below)
- Can multi task when needed
- Competent with the Racing Rules and Regulations and SSA Specifications.
- Hold a current Speedway Sedans Australia officials licence.
- Flexible with time as title teams are required from normally Wednesday fly in, till Sunday or sometimes Monday fly out. A technical and a steward maybe required to stay an extra day for postchecks.
- Have no association with a competitor or car owner at that particular title.

Title members will be required to attend the title from the start of scrutineering to the end of the event.

Title members will be required to sign a contract with Speedway Sedans Australia when selected to officiate at a national title.

Title members who pull out prior to a title maybe required to pay expenses incurred by the SSA.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR OFFICIALS

This document has been taken from section 25 Speedway Sedans Australia policy.

- Be impartial, consistent and objective at all times
- Understand the purpose of the rules of competition
- Be co-operative and understanding in the interpretation and application of rules or any penalties.
- Make a personal commitment to keep informed, sound principles and rule updates.
- Seek continual self improvement through study, performance appraisal and regular updating of competencies.
- Ensure behaviour is consistent with the principles of good behaviour. Actions speak louder than words.
- Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all competitors.
- Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
- Ensure that “spirit” of competition is maintained.
- Value the individual in sport.
- Avoid the use of derogatory language on gender or race.
- Refrain from any form of sexual harassment towards officials and competitors.
- Encourage understanding of; and access to knowledge, of all areas of officiating.
- Be a positive role model in behaviour and personal appearance.
- When dealing with a Junior Driver, you must have a Parent / Guardian present, as well as the driver’s representative.
