GRID DRAWS: Grid Draws will be conducted by SSNT.

MEETING FORMAT: 3 Rounds of heats x 10 laps

Maximum of 12 cars per heat

Subject to Car Numbers the Formats 1 – 4 below will be utilised for Finals

Format 1 - 40 CAR FIELD OR LESS

Top 16 qualify directly to A MAIN. - 35 Laps

Remainder to B Main, with 6 to transfer from B Main to positions 17 through to 22 for A MAIN (maximum 22 car field for B Main, subject to numbers) – 20 Laps or number of cars plus 1 lap. Minimum of 8 cars to start B Main

Format 2 - 41-60 CAR FIELD

Top 16 to qualify directly to A MAIN. - 35 Laps

2 - B mains (odds and evens positions 17 to 60) with THREE to transfer from either B Main to A MAIN (B mains odds top three to positions 17, 19, 21 and B Main evens top 3 to positions 18, 20, 22 of the A Main). – 20 Laps

- 3 Heats per Car. All points count.
- No repechage or Consolation.
- Lap times to determine position in the case of equal points to determine positions in A Main and B Mains.
- Highest point scorer to start from pole position in the A Main and B Mains.

PRESENTATIONS: SSNT will supply each starter in the A Main with a memento. Trophies for the top 3 placegetters will be

presented by SSNT Inc.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize Money \$2250.00 (inc GST)

TRACK: Pole Line – 380 metres – Clay surface

VENUE INFORMATION: Camping is allowed, driver needs to provide their own source of power, shower facilities available, water

available, parts and tyre vendors. Canteen on Saturday.

INSURANCE: Competitor Personal Accident Insurance is compulsory.

FUEL: Please refer to your car specification book for allowed fuel types.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Open to SSA/Speedway Australia Licensed Drivers and SSA Inc Registered Street Stocks..

- 2. Drivers Speedway Australia Licence Number and Registered vehicle's SSA Inc. Log Book Number must be included on the nomination, or it will not be accepted.
- 3. All vehicle engines must be sealed. Current Engine sealing sheet, computer sealing sheet (if applicable) and Daylight Sheet must be attached to your log book and presented along with your Speedway Australia Licence at scrutineering
- 4. Passengers are not allowed in vehicles at State Titles.
- 5. All nominations received after Saturday 15th July 2023 will be classed as late nominations and will be required to pay a late nomination fee of \$150.00 (inclusive of GST). Late nominations will not be received after the closure of scrutineering.
- 6. Nomination fees, once received, will not be refunded.
- 7. All tow, prize money will be paid no sooner than 21 days after the event (barring any appeals). No money will be paid at the track
- 8. All hired transponders *must* be returned at the end of the event.
- 9. SSNT reserves the right to refuse any Nomination.
- 10. AMB Orbits program will be used entirely to obtain competitor points and starting positions for the finals. In the case of equal points, lap times will be used to allocate starting grid positions. The B mains to have full grids where cars are available.
- 11. One way Communicators are compulsory, please ensure you have enough batteries for the duration of the meeting.
- 12. Your car number is also required as a decal (provided by yourself) on the rear bumper of your car to assist with line up formation.
- 13. Post race checks conducted after racing.
- 14. Competitors who are disqualified forfeit all entitlements to claim for or be paid any monies associated with the event.
- 15. Competitors are responsible for removal of tyres competitors who fail to comply will be charged a disposal fee by the
